



2010–2011 School Supply List for Grades Seven and Eight

*This is a list of supplies to begin the school year. Additional supplies may be requested throughout the year. Please do not send in large binders or trappers. The following supplies will be needed the first day of school. Desk accessories and additional writing implements are to be kept at home. Textbooks are to be covered with brown paper bags or cloth. Please do not use contact paper or any adhesive. Pencils and paper supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year. A new jump drive will be needed if the student does not have the one issued from the School last year. **Students in grades seven and eight will need a P.E. uniform.***

All middle school students need to have a Phoenix Public Library card for access to free databases available through the school library. Library cards may be obtained from any library branch. If the family already has a card, the student may use that number. To access the database, input the library card number and the last name of the cardholder.

For School – There are two options. The teachers will explain how each will operate.

- (1) main binder. This binder needs to have seven sections, two pocket dividers, and two zipper pouches inside the binder. **OR**
- (1) plastic accordion file and (7) ½" – 1" 3-ring hard cover notebooks. Viewfinders work the best for labeling purposes.
- assortment of pencils (**regular and colored**), highlighters, and pens to last the year
- package (500 sheets) of 3-hole lined paper **to last the year**
- assortment of sticky notes (1) 1½"x 2", (1) 3"x 3", (1) 3"x 5"
- jump drive (The School provides for students **new to the School**.)

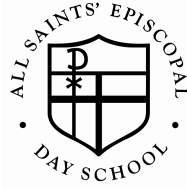
