Each middle school grade will have their own standard pak available for purchase. These are assembled from the supply lists approved by the Middle School Administration. The standard pak will include all the items requested by the school that need replacement every year (folders, binders, loose leaf paper, highlighters, etc). In addition to purchasing this prepackaged kit, you will have several options to ADD to your standard pack which will include Case It Binders, Accoridan Folders, Dictionary, Thesaurus, Flash Drive, Calculator, etc. Please note that because each grade level has a choice of binders, this item is not part of the standard kit – you will need to order your grade level School Pak and add the binder option of your choice.

School Pak will label your box with your child's name and grade and ship free to ASEDS. Orders must be placed by June 15<sup>th</sup> to qualify for free school shipping. If you miss the deadline, you can still order a pack before July 31<sup>st</sup> for home delivery with a modest charge.

We encourage you to use the school delivery option – not only will you save the shipping costs, but you will conveniently pick up your supplies on the first day of school. Katy Knoer is working with the school to carefully orchestrate the distribution of school delivered paks.
